

Delaney House (on the cover of *Squatter's Rights*) is a part of every book in the series. The dilapidated farmhouse where Grace and Connie nearly died is on the cover of *A Commission on Murder*. The river house that was David's last gift for Grace is in the background on *Bad Intent*. Ellender York's house (and her awful neighbor's), are depicted on *Death and Consequences*. The white Victorian where Grace and Cyrus Mosley have their law practice was the hardest to create, as it has two front doors, but I think the designers pulled it off for the cover of *Twisted Karma*.

For the cover of *In the Absence of Truth*, I wanted to show you the cottage Mac renovated for Grace. I had so much fun planning that house and giving Grace her dream kitchen. Here's another view of McNamara Cottage in its idyllic setting on the Little Wye River. I think the artists at MiblArt outdid themselves. I hope you like it as much as I do.
